JOB PURPOSE: Driving students and staff to various locations.

To transport by car or minibus, College students, staff and visitors to and from the Colleges and to various destinations.

To clean the vehicles as and when required.

To carry out basic maintenance of vehicles when required.

To deliver and collect vehicles from the service dealerships as and when required.

To carry out deliveries on an occasional basis as and when required.
